Insurance Lawyers Chilliwack - You are qualified to go to court if an insurance company violates the terms of a written agreement. However, the courts would typically just force the insurance firm to pay the amounts owed in accordance to the contract.

If an insurance company has withheld payments deliberately, you could be eligible for extra-contractual damages. These damages may be granted if the insurance company fabricates or ignores evidence in addition to providing partial data of your claim. The damages granted consist of costs such as interest payments and the loss of RRSPs, and compensation for mental suffering. Punitive and exemplary damages are awarded when insurance firms show specially malicious conduct.
